





Treatment for the Post-Antibiotic Age

For decades dentists have prescribed antibiotics for the treatment of gum disease, yet we still have very high rates of chronic periodontitis. If antibiotics worked well – and increasing they don't in the post-antibiotic age – we would have better outcomes. Perio Tray™ therapy overcomes the limitations of antibiotics by using Perio Gel™ with 1.7% hydrogen peroxide.

With the deep Perio Tray™ delivery, the peroxide's oxidizing action debrides the slimy matrix covering the biofilm and dissolves the most exposed bacterial cells. Peroxide's oxygenation promotes healthy bacterial repopulation at the expense of pathogens. As inflammation begins to subside, the host has new opportunity to heal.*

Perio Tray™ therapy is prescribed as adjunctive homecare for patients in all stages of disease. Intervening at the earliest signs of disease gives you a pro-active approach to improve patient health and prevent tissue destruction. Perio Protect also helps address patient fears of treatment and is especially important for patients with co-morbidities.

Because Perio Tray™ therapy improves gingival health, your Perio Protect patients will enjoy optimal restorative results. This is a great way to keep gingival margins clean around crowns and implants.







Proven to Reduce Biofilms, Inflammation, and Pocket Depths

LIVE/DEAD™ dye studies showed that Perio Gel™ 1.7% hydrogen peroxide effectively debrided the gooey slime matrix of *streptococcus mutans* biofilms and the bacterial cell walls on the outer layers of the biofilm within 10 minutes. Repeated applications delaminate the biofilm layer by layer.

The hydrogen peroxide in Perio Gel[™] also releases oxygen into pockets, modifying the subgingival microenvironment. *In vivo* microbiological analyses show that Perio Tray[™] delivery of Perio Gel[™] 1.7% hydrogen peroxide resulted in significant reductions in biofilm populations and prevented pathogenic bacteria from reforming efficient microbial communities.

Scanning electron microscope analyses of subgingival biofilms confirmed substantial decreases in bacterial populations and regrowth of bacteria that live in harmony with the host gum tissue: actinomyces-like and aerobic cocci-like bacteria. When you can manage the biofilm effectively, you can help manage the disease more effectively.


Not all 1.7% peroxide gels work as effectively as the Perio GelTM formulation. The formulation matters.





The image on the left shows a vibrant biofilm community that grew on a carrier in a 6mm pocket before treatment. The image at right of a carrier in the same pocket after 17 days of treatment indicates that the biofilm has nearly dissolved. Schaudinn C, et al. In human clinical trials, pocket depths and bleeding decreased significantly with adjunctive Perio TrayTM delivery, both before and after SRP. These improvements are good news for all patients, but, for medically compromised patients for whom bacteremia and oral inflammation increase risks, the improvements before mechanical intervention are especially noteworthy.


Helping Patients Keep Their Teeth

Perio Tray[™] prescriptions can be documented in your office with these CDT codes:

D5995 Periodontal medicament carrier with peripheral seal – maxillary.

A custom fabricated, laboratory processed carrier that covers the teeth and alveolar mucosa. Used as a vehicle to deliver prescribed medicaments for sustained contact with the gingiva, alveolar mucosa, and into the periodontal sulcus or pocket.

D5996 Periodontal medicament carrier with peripheral seal - mandibular.

A custom fabricated, laboratory processed carrier that covers the teeth and alveolar mucosa. Used as a vehicle to deliver prescribed medicaments for sustained contact with the gingiva, alveolar mucosa, and into the periodontal sulcus or pocket.

HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNTS (HSA) & MEDICAL FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNTS (FSA)

The FDA cleared Perio TrayTM medicament carriers and the medications prescribed for use in them can be submitted for HSAs and medical FSAs.
